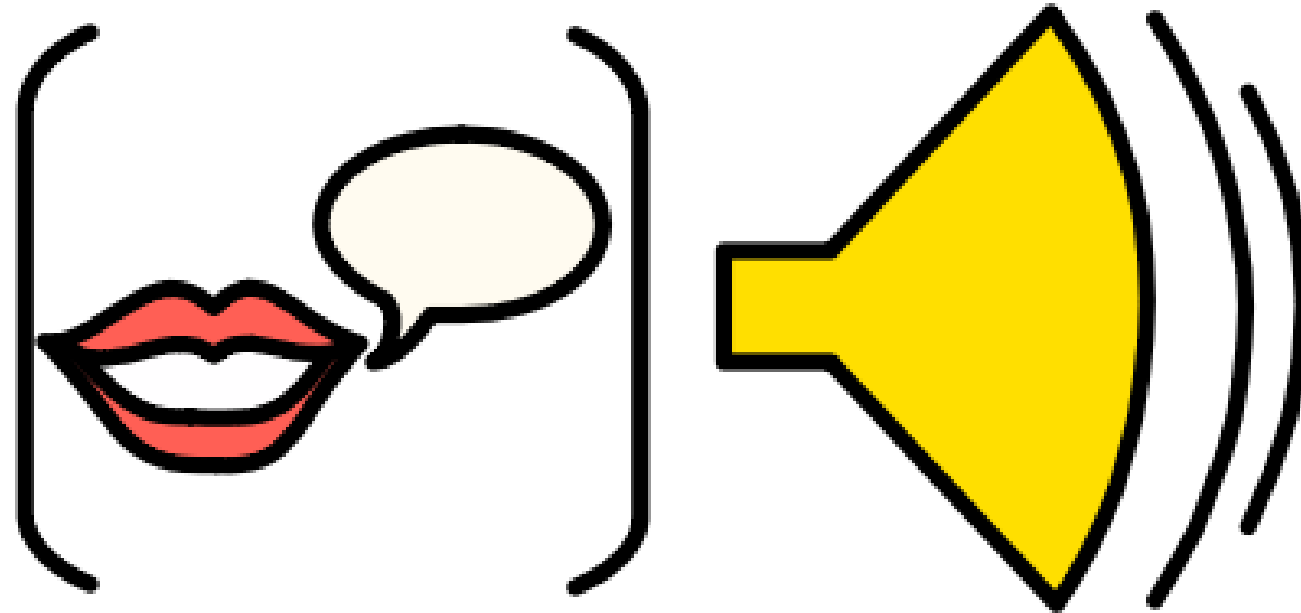

**1. Watch the video on how to do the speech sound action. Repeat it several times.**



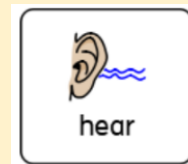
**2. Listen to a song and say the speech sound.**

*Make sure your child can see your mouth as you speak and can hear you clearly.*

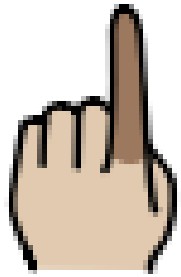
