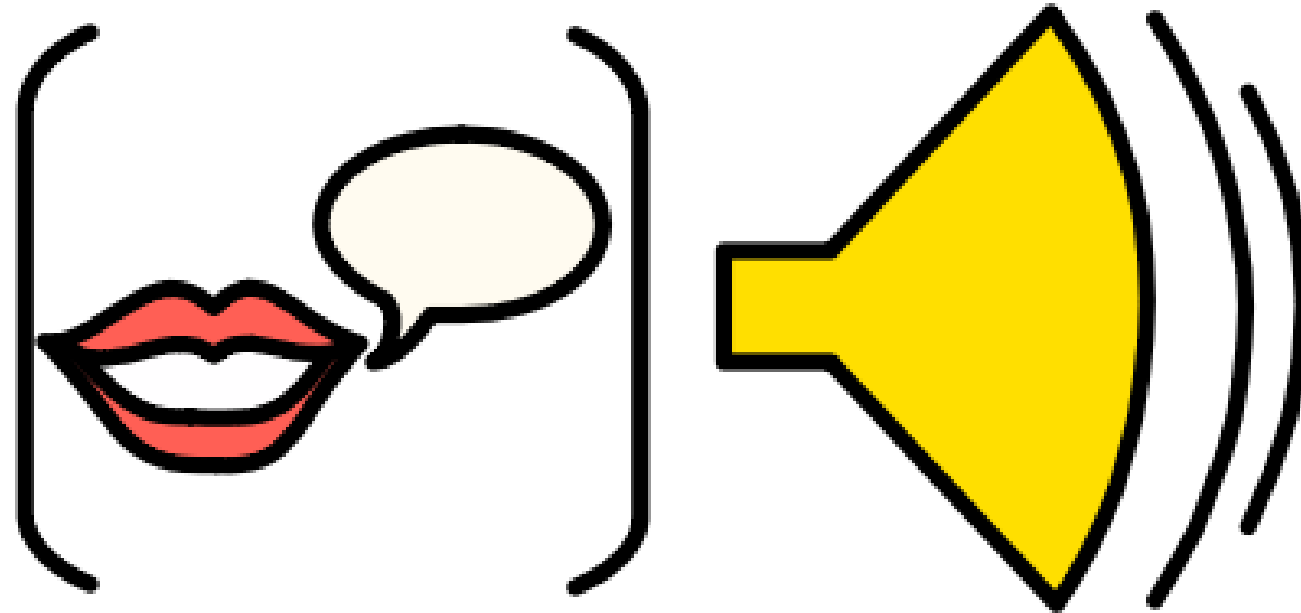




Speech Sounds

1. Watch the video on how to do the speech sound action. Repeat it several times.



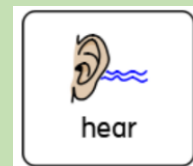
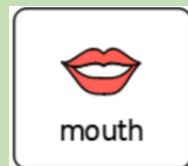
2. Listen to a song and say the speech sound.



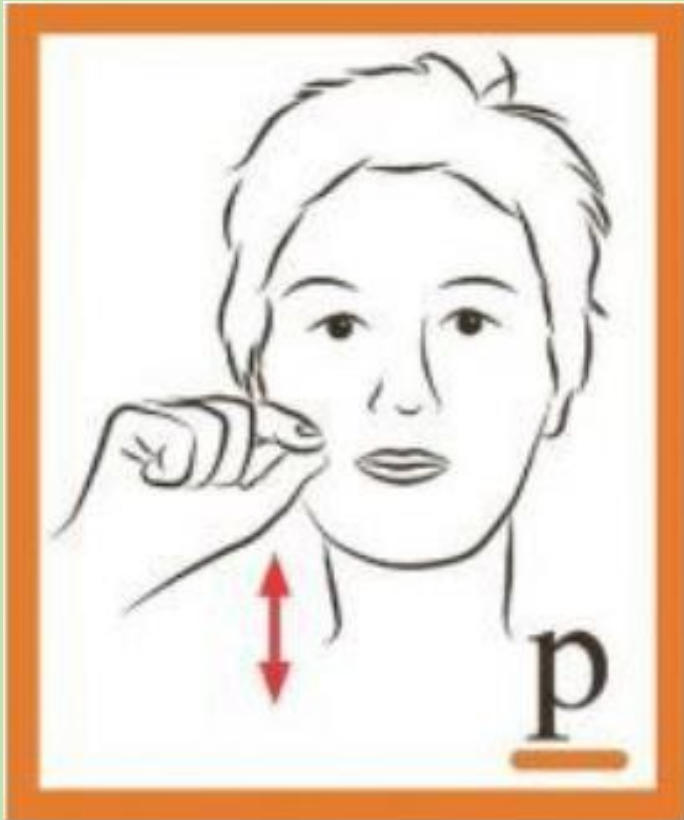
3. Choose an activity to do together. During the activity, repeat the speech sound often.
